

## **School route plan for Gernerplatz primary school**

Dear Parents,

Road traffic is a big daily challenge for your child, especially as a new school starter. We would like to support you with this school route plan as part of the child-friendly municipality of Puchheim. Your child should be able to get to school and back home safely. The school route map, primarily aimed for pedestrians, shows you which crossings and crossing aids your child can use to reach school. Remember to always be a good role model for your child on the road. Explain the road traffic regulations to him/her and practice the rules with them. Your child should wear bright, clearly visible clothing, ideally the high-visibility vest given to them in the first grade.

There are many advantages of your child walking to school. Your child will gain an understanding of safety in and around traffic. Additionally, they can discover beautiful places on their way to school that they may have missed in the car. Another advantage is that your child can get some movement and exercise before going to school, where hours of sitting are often required. If you do take your child to school by car, please stop at one of the "parents' stops" shown on this map and let your child complete the last part of the journey on foot.

Your school organizes the "Walk to School" campaign. By taking part you can help to minimize dangerous traffic situations in front of our schools in Puchheim and make a small contribution to climate protection.

We want the school route plan to always be up to date and welcome any suggestions for improvement.

## AGENDA

1. Dangerous area Alpenstrasse / Lagerstrasse Very high traffic volume, especially in the morning.
2. Dangerous area – Play stree Rotwandstrasse / Gernerplatz High volume of traffic from cars and bicycles.
3. Dangerous area Bäumlstrasse / Gernerplatz Confusing area. Do not cross the street directly at the curve. Use school helper crossing.
4. Dangerous area Obere Lagerstrasse / Rainerstrasse Crosses the school path of secondary schools.
5. Dangerous area Lagerstrasse / Nordendstrasse Busy intersection without a pedestrian crossing.
